The meeting was called to order by Frank at 7:10pm

Treasurer's Report given by Kelli Miller

- \$13,810 in the account. This does not include \$175 for referee fees or \$500 for a field hockey tournament

Wrestling Report given by Erik Keiper

- Erik presented the wrestling budget for the 2012-13 season. He is asking for the followig:
 - 50 Singlets @ approx \$32 each
 - 2 Flip A Score boards totaling \$77
 - 5 cases of mat cleaner at \$125 per case
 - 10 rolls of mat tape at \$6.50 per roll
 - 2 cases of ice packs at \$13.96 per case
 - 100 piece medical kit for \$19.50
 - Referee fees to be announced at league meeting in November
 - MTAA to cover cost of between 10 & 15 boys to go to the Schoolboy Tournament. Cost TBD. Was \$15 per wrestler last year
- Erik also asked that the board approve Jon Moyer as co-commissioner of wrestling.

Girls Basketball Report given by Cori Olmeda

- Cori will be checking equipment and uniforms in the next week or two to see what is needed for this season
- This year, there will be separate travel teams for 5th & 6th grade rather than combined like previous years

Boys Basketball Report - No report given. No commissioner present

Cheer Report given by Jenn Eberhart

- There is some concern over the concession stand coverage. Football parents are supposed to cover practices and cheer parents must cover during games but, so far, the concession stand has not been open during practices.
- Parents were told, if they do not cover concession stand, the girls will not cheer.
